



The Final Plagues:

Lesson 29 Visuals

- **The first five plagues were blood, frogs, flies, gnats, and livestock.**
- **The 6th plague was boils.**
- **The 7th plague was hail.**
- **It hailed in all of Egypt except in Goshen, where the Israelites lived.**
- **Pharaoh said he sinned and would let the Israelites go to the desert wilderness for a three-day trip to sacrifice to the Lord God.**



- **After the hail stopped, he changed his mind and would not let them go.**
- **Pharaoh then said only the men could go. Moses and Aaron did not agree with that because God had said everyone was to go.**
- **Because Pharaoh wouldn't agree to let everyone go, the 8th plague came. The 8th plague was locusts.**
- **The 9th plague was darkness.**
- **It was completely dark and the sun didn't shine for three days.**



- **Pharaoh said all the Israelites could go but their sheep and cows could not go.**
- **Moses and Aaron would not agree to go without their sheep and goats because God told them to take their livestock.**
- **They needed livestock to sacrifice their sheep and cows to God.**
- **The final plague was the plague of the firstborn.**



- **Moses warned Pharaoh that his firstborn son would die in his home and every firstborn son in Egypt would die in their homes.**
- **The last five plagues were Boils, Hail, Locust, Darkness, and Firstborn.**
- **God gave instructions to the Israelites to prepare for Passover, the night when all the firstborn sons would be killed.**
- **The Israelites were to keep an unblemished, perfect one-year old sheep or goat in their home like a pet for four days.**



- **On the 14th day, blood from that perfect lamb or goat was to put on the doorframes of the Israelite homes.**
- **The Lord explained that He would pass through the land of Egypt and strike every firstborn male, both of people and animals, in the land of Egypt.**
- **Then the Lord said, “I am the Lord. I will execute judgments on the gods of Egypt.”**



- **The Lord said that when He sees the blood on the doorframes, He will “pass-over” so that no one will die in that home.**
