Nebuchadnezzar's Dream & Fiery Furnace – 2 Chronicles 36, Daniel 2-3

- 1) What would happen to Daniel, his friends and all the wise men if Daniel cannot tell King Nebuchadnezzar what happened in the King's dream and its meaning?
ANSWER: They would be killed.
- 2) After Daniel told Nebuchadnezzar his dream and the meaning, who did Nebuchadnezzar make ruler over the entire province of Babylon and place all the wise men under him?
ANSWER: Daniel
- 3) Who did Daniel request to be his administrators over the province of Babylon?
ANSWER: Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego.
- 4) Who set up a statue that was ninety feet tall and nine feet wide?
ANSWER: King Nebuchadnezzar
- 5) What would happen to anyone who refused to worship this statue?
ANSWER: They would be thrown into the fiery furnace
- 6) Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego said, "If we are thrown into the fiery furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it. Then they said, "But even if God does not deliver us, we will not serve your gods or _____ the image of gold you have set up."
ANSWER: worship
- 7) Nebuchadnezzar was then so angry that he ordered for the fiery furnace to be heated up _____ times hotter.
ANSWER: seven
- 8) What happened to the men who carried Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego to the fiery furnace?
ANSWER: They were killed by the flames because the flames were so intense.
- 9) How many men did Nebuchadnezzar see walking around in the fire unharmed?
ANSWER: four
- 10) What was their condition when they walked out of the fire?
ANSWER: completely unharmed (not even a hair burned, not even the smell of smoke on their clothes)
